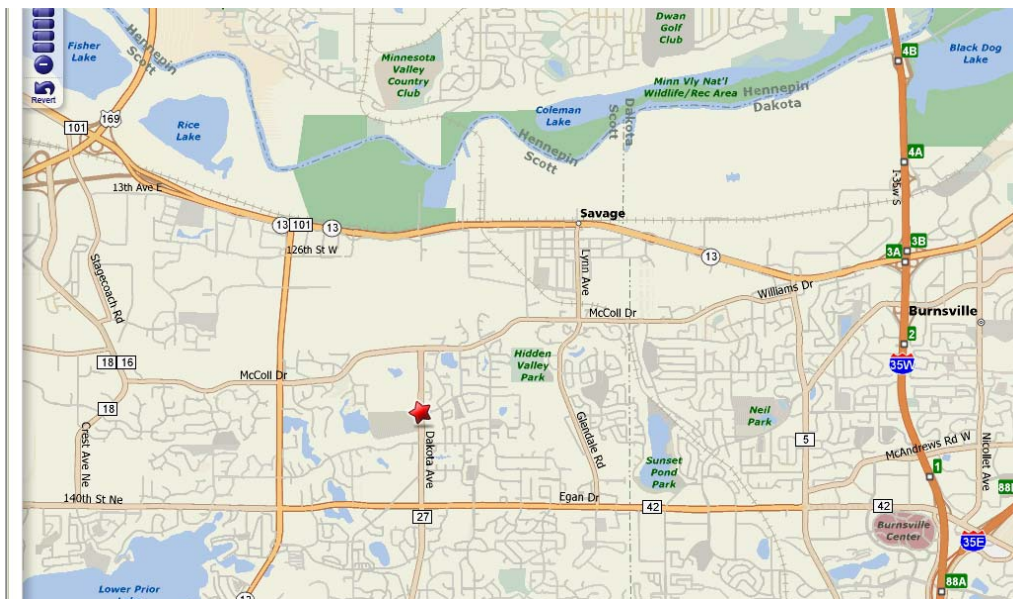

DIRECTIONS TO THE FACILITY

From the north or south -- Take I35E or I35W to the County Rd 42 exit in Burnsville, MN. Head west on CR-42 approximately 4 miles to Dakota Ave (County Road 27 – watch for the water tower). Turn right (north) onto Dakota Ave/CR-27. Savage Community Park is approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile north, on the west side of the street. Parking is available at the north and south ends of the park.

From the west -- Take I494 to the US-169 exit (Exits 10A and 10B) in Eden Prairie, MN. Head south on US-169 approximately $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the MN-13 Savage/CR-101 Shakopee exit. Take the MN-13 ramp toward Savage, merging onto CR-101 (a total of about 2 miles), then turn right (south) onto MN-13. Take MN-13 approximately 1.2 miles; turn left onto McColl Drive/CR-16. Take McColl Drive/CR-16 approximately 1 mile; turn right (south) onto Dakota Ave/CR-27. Savage Community Park is approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south, on the west side of the street. Parking is available at the north and south ends of the park.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial.

The current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free of charge from the NADAC website: www.nadac.com. Exhibitors may request a hard copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook by sending \$5 to:

- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by dogs and handlers at all times.
- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC agility trials. Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- Dogs MUST be registered with NADAC to compete. All dogs must have a NADAC Registration Number when entering this event.
- Any dog that demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog whether inside the ring or outside the ring, may be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner may be excused from the agility trial.
- The trial Committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by NADAC. Anyone currently not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- Refunds minus administration fees will be made if a Veterinarian's certificate of proof of injury or illness of the dog or a bitch in heat is submitted to the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO CHECK IN ON September 4, 2010.
- This event will be held outdoors on grass.
- All exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children engage in disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case no refund of entries will be made.
- The Club, its agents or assigns will not be responsible for the loss of damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Dogs must be on leash anywhere on the show grounds property, or in crates when not competing in the ring. NO dogs may be tied to fences, cars, trees or other obstacles at any time.
- Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone not picking up after dogs or pottying dogs in "dog free" areas will be asked to leave without refund.

- No leads, collars, food, toys, balls clickers or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No food, toys, balls or other training devices may be used within ten (10) feet of the entrance to the ring.
- Crating will be on dirt or concrete. We recommend bringing a mat to place under your crates.
- Placement ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes except the Chances class, which is a pass/fail class. Ribbons will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score.
- Check-in and Measuring: Check-in and measuring dogs jumping 16" and under will begin Saturday at 7:00 AM. All dogs not jumping 20" or 20+" and without permanent cards must be measured. All dogs entered in the Skilled Category do not need to be measured. For dogs not entered on Saturday, check-in will be from 7:00 AM to 7:30 AM on Sunday.
- Closing Date and Move-ups: Closing date for entries is August 25, 2010. After this time move-ups to entries received prior to close will be accepted in writing via mail or e-mail until 6:00 p.m. August, 30, 2010. There will be no day to day move-ups at this trial.
- Final confirmations will be e-mailed out the first week in September. Please read your confirmations carefully and notify the trial secretary (JrtsDoItAll@aol.com) or by phone (612 276-9854) if there are any corrections that need to be made. If changes need to be made the day of the trial there will be a \$5 charge per class.
- Equipment to be used may include jumps (wing and/or wingless), a-frame, dog walk, open tunnels, weave poles, and hoops. All contacts are rubber surfaced.
- The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.
When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.
- Non-Jumping Classes—Veteran or Disabled Handler. Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.
- Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both the exhibitor and the owner of the entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1. As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents. As used here 'MMBC' means Minnesota Mixed Breed Club its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
2. Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
3. Exhibitor/owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), the Minnesota Mixed Breed Club (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the City of Savage, MN (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial. I/We certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or to other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above.
